Roddy Romero & the Hub City All-Stars- are renowned, Grammy nominated Louisiana band who have been performing internationally at the most prestigious festivals and venues for over 20 years. They are celebrated not only for their authenticity when performing or recording traditional Cajun and Zydeco music indigenous to South Louisiana, but also for their original songwriting which stays true to "Louisiana Roots" inspirations. This band is the perfect fit since Roddie and Chad are direct descendants from the original Spanish founder of New Iberia.



Feu Follet - A band deeply rooted in the francophone soil of Louisiana and pushing boldly into unexplored yet utterly natural varieties of Cajun experience. The groups widely acclaimed 2010 release "EnCouleurs" has won a Grammy nomination for Best Zydeco or Cajun Music Album. Leticia's unique style of blending modern rhythms of musical influences from all over the world combined with classical techniques has made her a sought after commodity and a true master of the Flamenco arts.
