

NOTICE OF INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following entitled ordinance was introduced at a meeting of City Council of the City of New Iberia, acting as the Governing Authority (the "Governing Authority") of the City of New Iberia, State of Louisiana, held on Wednesday, January 2nd, 2019, and laid over for publication of notice:

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02

An introduction of an ordinance fixing the terms of an Agreement and Agricultural Lease with Tony Richardson for unimproved property belonging to the City of New Iberia and situated in the vicinity of Sucrose Lane for the purpose of planting, cultivating and harvesting certain crops, and authorizing the Mayor to execute the aforementioned lease and any additional documents that he deems appropriate to accomplish the foregoing. The term of the lease shall extend through December 31, 2023, and the City shall receive one-sixth (1/6th) of the gross revenue derived by the Lessee from the sale of all crops from the leased land described as follows:

Tracts 1 (containing 1.1 acres), 2 (containing 2.95 acres), 3 (containing 3.16 acres) 4 (containing 7.62 acres), 5 (containing 1.3 acres) 6 (containing 1.16 acres), 7 (containing 7.49 acres) 11 (containing 1.74 acres) and 12 (containing 2.52 acres) as set forth on the U.S.D.A. Farm Service Agency Map, and identified as Farm 2211, Tract 2876.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the Governing Authority will meet on **February 19, 2019, at five-thirty (5:30) o'clock p.m.**, at the Regular Meeting Room of the City Hall Council Chambers, New Iberia, Louisiana, at which time there will be a public hearing on the adoption of the aforesaid ordinance.
